BUDGET WORK SESSION

REVIEW OF PROPOSED DRAFT BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024

Town Manager Tammy Michael presented the proposed draft budget for fiscal year 2023-2024.

As proposed, the tax rate would remain the same at five (5) cents per one hundred dollars valuation.

REVENUES

APPROPRIATIONS

General Fund

- □ Administration Increase from \$404,274 to \$411,374
- □ Public Safety Remains the same
- □ Public Works
 - Public Works Utilities & Services
 - Increase in GFL for trash collection and recycling services from \$350,00 to \$386,000
 - Increase in mowing from \$36,000 to \$40,000
 - Public Works Town Park Capital Outlay
 - Construction of additional parking area and paving existing lot \$1,000,000
 - Construction of equipment storage building \$500,000
- □ Planning and Zoning Remains the same
- □ Cultural and Economic Development Remains the same

Following discussion, adjustments to appropriations were made as follows:

Governing Board

□ Increase Accounting Fees for audit from \$5,500 to \$6,500

Administration

- □ Increase Insurance and Bonding from \$15,000 to \$25,000
- □ Increase Utilities-Poles for Lights at interchange of Highway 52/Hickory Road interchange from \$2,500 to \$3,000

Public Works

- Town Park Operating Costs, Salaries, etc.
 Add line item for shelter supplies

 - Add line item for software •
