CALL TO ORDER

BUDGET WORK SESSION

REVIEW OF UPDATED PROPOSED DRAFT BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025

Town Manager Tammy Michael presented the updated proposed draft budget for Fiscal Year 2024-2025 to Council for their review.

REVENUES

□ Total recurring revenues are the same as what was presented at the last budget session other than another month was added.

APPROPRIATIONS

General Fund

- ☐ Governing Board Increase from \$49,400 to \$54,400
- ☐ Administration Increase from \$471,242 to \$558,350
- \square Public Safety Remains the same.
- □ Public Works
 - O Utilities & Services Increase from \$502,600 to \$568,200.
 - \circ Town Park Recreation and Development Capital Outlay Increase from \$1,600,000 to \$1,700,000
 - o Town Park Operating Costs, Salaries, etc. Remains the same \$385,000
 - Town Manager stated the new park attended will start working on May 7, 2024

Following discussion of the updated proposed budget, the following additional changes were made:

APPROPRIATIONS

- ☐ Governing Board
 - o Travel/Meetings increased by \$5,000.
- □ Administration
 - o Mayor Pro Tem Mike McAlpine would like to appropriate a salary amount so the Council can have an amount to negotiate with. Possible Salary amount instead of an hourly rate.
 - o Cell Phone Councilor Jackie Edwards stated she spoke with Spectrum and service is free for one year then \$29 a month with no contract.
- □ Public Works
 - o Additional Lighting on Hickory Tree Road \$5,000.
- □ Cultural Recreation, Economic Development
 - Orants to Schools (S.T.E.A.M.) Councilor Jackie Edwards stated, if possible, it would be a good idea to know where the money goes that the Town gives to the schools. Town Manager Tammy Michael stated that someone from Midway Elementary School would be attending the May 6, 2024 Council meeting about the appreciation for the S.T.E.AM. Grant.

CAPITAL RECOVERY FEES

Mayor Pro Tem Mike McAlpine stated the Capital Recovery Fees have not been increased since August 2010. At the February 22, 2024 Vision Session a copy of the proposed increase in rates were handed out to Council for their review and input.

Council reviewed the proposed increases as follows:
